3**THEN THEOS SPOKE:** "LET THERE BE LIGHT!" AND THERE WAS LIGHT. 4AND THEOS BEHELD THE LIGHT, THAT IT WAS GOOD. AND THEOS SEPARATED BETWEEN THE LIGHT, AND BETWEEN THE DARKNESS. 5AND THEOS CALLED THE LIGHT DAY, AND THE DARKNESS HE CALLED NIGHT. AND IT BECAME EVENING, AND DAYBREAK CAME, **DAY ONE**.

6**THEN THEOS SPOKE:** "LET THERE BE A FIRMAMENT IN THE MIDST OF THE WATER, AND BE IT SEPARATING BETWEEN WATER AND WATER!" AND THUS IT HAPPENED, 7AND THEOS MADE THE FIRMAMENT. AND THEOS SEPARATED BETWEEN THE WATER, WHICH WAS UNDER THE FIRMAMENT, AND BETWEEN THE WATER ABOVE THE FIRMAMENT. 8AND THEOS CALLED THE FIRMAMENT HEAVEN. AND THEOS BEHELD THAT IT WAS GOOD. AND IT BECAME EVENING, AND DAYBREAK CAME, **SECOND DAY**.

9**THEN THEOS SPOKE:** "LET THE WATER UNDER THE HEAVEN BE GATHERED INTO ONE ASSEMBLY, AND LET THE DRY LAND BE VISIBLE!" AND THUS IT HAPPENED, AND THE WATER UNDER THE HEAVEN WAS GATHERED INTO THEIR ASSEMBLIES, AND THE DRY LAND BECAME VISIBLE. 10AND THEOS CALLED THE DRY LAND EARTH, AND THE SYSTEMS OF THE WATERS HE CALLED SEAS. 14**THEN THEOS SPOKE:** "LET THERE BE LUMINARIES IN THE FIRMAMENT OF THE HEAVEN FOR AN ILLUMINATION OF THE EARTH, THE ONES TO SEPARATE BETWEEN THE DAY AND BETWEEN THE NIGHT! AND LET THEM BE FOR SIGNS AND FOR SEASONS, AND FOR DAYS AND FOR YEARS! 15AND LET THEM BE FOR AN ILLUMINATION IN THE FIRMAMENT OF THE HEAVEN, SO AS TO SHINE UPON THE EARTH!" AND THUS IT HAPPENED, 16AND THEOS MADE THE TWO GREAT LUMINARIES, THE GREAT LUMINARY FOR A RULE OF THE DAY, AND THE LESSER LUMINARY FOR A RULE OF THE NIGHT, AND THE STARS. 17AND THEOS SET THEM IN THE FIRMAMENT OF THE HEAVEN, SO AS TO SHINE UPON THE EARTH, 18AND TO RULE THE DAY AND THE NIGHT, AND TO SEPARATE BETWEEN THE LIGHT AND BETWEEN THE DARKNESS. AND THEOS BEHELD THAT IT WAS GOOD. 19AND IT BECAME EVENING, AND DAYBREAK CAME, **FOURTH DAY**.

20**THEN THEOS SPOKE:** "LET THE WATERS LEAD FORTH LIVING SOULS OF HERPTILES, AND BIRDS FLYING OVER THE EARTH ABOUT THE FIRMAMENT OF THE HEAVEN!" AND THUS IT HAPPENED, 21AND THEOS MADE THE GREAT SEA CREATURES AND EVERY SOUL OF LIVING BEINGS OF HERPTILES, WHICH THE WATERS LED FORTH ACCORDING TO THEIR KINDS, AND EVERY WINGED BIRD ACCORDING TO KIND. AND THEOS BEHELD THAT THEY WERE GOOD. 22AND THEOS BLESSED THEM, EXPOUNDING: "BE FRUITFUL AND MULTIPLY AND FILL THE WATERS IN THE SEAS, AND LET THE BIRDS MULTIPLY UPON THE EARTH!" 23AND IT BECAME EVENING, AND DAYBREAK CAME, **FIFTH DAY**.

24**THEN THEOS SPOKE:** "LET THE EARTH BRING FORTH A LIVING SOUL ACCORDING TO KIND, TETRAPODS AND HERPTILES AND WILD BEASTS OF THE EARTH, ACCORDING TO KIND!" AND THUS IT HAPPENED, 25AND THEOS MADE THE WILD BEASTS OF THE EARTH ACCORDING TO KIND, AND THE DOMESTIC ANIMALS ACCORDING TO KIND, AND ALL THE HERPTILES OF THE EARTH ACCORDING TO THEIR KIND. AND THEOS BEHELD THAT THEY WERE GOOD.

26AND THEOS SPOKE: "LET US MAKE A MAN ACCORDING TO OUR IMAGE, AND THROUGH ASSIMILATION. AND LET THEM RULE THE FISHES OF THE SEA AND THE BIRDS OF HEAVEN, AND THE DOMESTIC ANIMALS AND ALL THE EARTH, AND ALL THE HERPTILES CRAWLING ON THE EARTH!" 27AND THEOS MADE THE MAN, ACCORDING TO THE IMAGE OF THEOS HE MADE HIM, MALE AND FEMALE HE MADE THEM. 28AND THEOS BLESSED THEM, EXPOUNDING: "BE FRUITFUL AND MULTIPLY AND FILL THE EARTH AND EXERCISE DOMINION OVER IT, AND RULE THE FISHES OF THE SEA AND THE BIRDS OF HEAVEN, AND ALL THE DOMESTIC ANIMALS AND ALL THE EARTH, AND ALL THE HERPTILES CRAWLING ON THE EARTH!" 29AND THEOS SPOKE: "BEHOLD, I HAVE GIVEN TO YOU EVERY PLANTED GARDEN SCATTERING SEED, WHICH IS UPON ALL THE EARTH, AND EVERY TREE WHICH HAS IN ITSELF FRUIT OF PLANTED SEED - FOR YOU IT WILL BE FOOD - 30AND TO ALL THE WILD BEASTS OF THE EARTH, AND TO ALL THE BIRDS OF HEAVEN, AND TO EVERY HERPTILE CRAWLING ON THE EARTH, WHICH HAS IN ITSELF LIFE OF A SOUL - LIKEWISE EVERY GREEN PLANT FOR FOOD." AND THUS IT HAPPENED. 31THEN THEOS BEHELD ALL THE THINGS WHICH HE MADE, AND BEHOLD, THEY WERE VERY GOOD. AND IT BECAME EVENING, AND DAYBREAK CAME, **SIXTH DAY**.

1THEN WERE CONSUMMATED THE HEAVEN AND THE EARTH, AND ALL THEIR COSMOS. 2AND THEOS CONSUMMATED ON THE SIXTH DAY HIS WORKS WHICH HE MADE, AND HE PAUSED ON THE SEVENTH DAY FROM ALL HIS WORKS WHICH HE MADE. 3AND THEOS BLESSED THE SEVENTH DAY AND HALLOWED IT, BECAUSE ON IT HE PAUSED FROM ALL HIS WORKS, WHICH THEOS BEGAN TO DO.

4THIS IS THE BOOK OF THE GENESIS OF HEAVEN AND EARTH, WHEN IT CAME TO BE, IN THE DAY THEOS MADE THE HEAVEN AND THE EARTH, 5AND BEFORE THE EMERGENCE OF EVERY GREEN OF THE FIELD ON THE EARTH, AND BEFORE THE RISING OF EVERY PLANT OF THE FIELD. FOR THEOS HAD NOT RAINED UPON THE EARTH, AND A MAN WAS NOT, TO WORK THE EARTH, 6BUT A WELL WAS RISING OUT OF THE EARTH, AND WAS WATERING ALL THE FACE OF THE EARTH.

7THEN THEOS SHAPED THE MAN FROM A MASS OF THE EARTH, AND HE BREATHED ON HIS FACE A BREATH OF LIFE, AND THE MAN BECAME A LIVING SOUL.

8AND **KYRIOS** THE THEOS PLANTED A PARADISE EASTWARD IN EDEN, AND HE SET THERE THE MAN WHOM HE HAD SHAPED. 9AND THEOS ALSO ROSE UP FROM THE EARTH EVERY TREE BEAUTIFUL TO THE SIGHT AND GOOD FOR FOOD, AND THE TREE OF LIFE IN THE MIDST OF THE PARADISE, AND THE TREE OF THE ACQUAINTED KNOWLEDGE OF GOOD, AND OF EVIL.

10NOW A RIVER COMES FORTH OUT OF EDEN, TO WATER THE PARADISE. FROM THERE IT DIVIDES INTO FOUR HEADS. 11THE NAME TO THE ONE IS PHISON. THIS IS THE ONE ENCIRCLING ALL THE LAND OF HEVILAT, THERE WHERE THE GOLD IS. 12AND THE GOLD OF THAT LAND IS GOOD. THERE IS ALSO THE CARBUNCLE AND THE GREENSTONE. 13AND THE NAME TO THE SECOND RIVER IS GIHON. THIS IS THE ONE ENCIRCLING ALL THE LAND OF ETHIOPIA. 14AND THE THIRD RIVER IS TIGRIS. THIS IS THE ONE GOING FORTH IN FRONT OF THE ASSYRIANS. AND THE FOURTH RIVER, THIS IS EUPHRATES.

15AND KYRIOS THE THEOS TOOK THE MAN WHOM HE HAD SHAPED, AND HE SET HIM IN THE PARADISE, TO WORK AND TO KEEP IT. 16AND KYRIOS THE THEOS CHARGED ADAM, SAYING: "FROM EVERY TREE IN THE PARADISE YOU WILL EAT FOOD, 17BUT FROM THE TREE, THE ONE TO KNOW GOOD AND EVIL, FROM IT YOU WILL NOT EAT! BUT IN WHATEVER DAY YOU MIGHT HAVE EATEN FROM IT, YOU WILL DIE TO DEATH."

18THEN KYRIOS THE THEOS SPOKE: "IT IS NOT GOOD FOR THE MAN, TO BE ALONE. LET US MAKE HIM A HELPER ACCORDING TO HIM." 19AND THEOS SHAPED YET OUT OF THE EARTH ALL THE WILD BEASTS OF THE FIELD, AND ALL THE BIRDS OF HEAVEN. AND HE LED THEM TO ADAM, TO SEE WHAT HE WILL CALL THEM. AND ANYTHING, WHATEVER ADAM CALLED THIS LIVING SOUL, THIS WAS ITS NAME. 20AND ADAM CALLED TO ALL

THE DOMESTIC ANIMALS NAMES, AND TO ALL THE BIRDS OF HEAVEN, AND TO ALL THE WILD BEASTS OF THE FIELD. BUT TO ADAM, A HELPER LIKENED TO HIM WAS NOT FOUND.

21 THEN THEOS IMPOSED AN ECSTASY UPON ADAM, AND HE FELL ASLEEP. AND HE TOOK ONE OF HIS RIBS, AND FILLED UP FLESH FOR IT. 22 AND KYRIOS THE THEOS UPBUILT THE RIB WHICH HE TOOK FROM ADAM, INTO A WOMAN, AND HE LED HER TO ADAM. 23 AND ADAM SAID: "THIS NOW IS BONE OUT OF MY BONES, AND FLESH OUT OF MY FLESH. SHE WILL BE CALLED 'WOMAN', FOR OUT OF HER MAN SHE WAS TAKEN." 24 ON ACCOUNT OF THIS, A MAN WILL LEAVE HIS FATHER AND MOTHER, AND HE WILL BE JOINED CLOSELY TO HIS WIFE. AND THE TWO WILL BECOME ONE FLESH.

1 AND THE TWO WERE NAKED, BOTH ADAM AND HIS WIFE, AND THEY WERE NOT ASHAMED. BUT THE SERPENT WAS THE MOST ASTUTE OF ALL THE WILD BEASTS ON THE EARTH, WHICH KYRIOS THE THEOS MADE. AND THE SERPENT SAID TO THE WOMAN: "WHY IS IT THAT THEOS SAID, YOU SHOULD BY NO MEANS EAT FROM EVERY TREE IN THE PARADISE?" 2 THEN THE WOMAN SAID TO THE SERPENT: "FROM A FRUIT OF A TREE OF THE PARADISE WE WILL EAT, 3 BUT FROM A FRUIT OF THE TREE WHICH IS IN THE MIDST OF THE PARADISE, SPOKE THEOS, YOU WILL NOT EAT FROM IT, NOR SHOULD YOU EVER TOUCH IT, SO THAT YOU MIGHT NOT DIE." 4 AND THE SERPENT SAID TO THE WOMAN: "YOU WILL NOT DIE TO DEATH. 5 FOR THEOS HAD KNOWN THAT IN WHATEVER DAY YOU MIGHT HAVE EATEN FROM IT, YOUR EYES WILL BE WHOLLY OPENED, AND YOU WILL BE LIKE THEOI, KNOWING GOOD AND EVIL." 6 THEN THE WOMAN SAW THAT THE TREE IS GOOD FOR FOOD AND THAT IT IS PLEASING TO THE EYES TO BEHOLD, AND BEAUTIFUL TO CONTEMPLATE. AND HAVING ATTAINED OF ITS FRUIT, SHE ATE. AND SHE GAVE ALSO TO HER HUSBAND AFTER HER, AND THEY ATE. 7 THEN WERE WHOLLY OPENED THE EYES OF THE TWO, AND THEY KNEW THAT THEY WERE NAKED. AND THEY INTERWEAVED LEAVES OF A FIG TREE, AND THEY MADE LOINCLOTHS TO THEMSELVES.

8 THEN THEY HEARD THE SOUND OF KYRIOS THE THEOS, WALKING AROUND IN THE PARADISE LATE THAT DAY. AND THEY HID, BOTH ADAM AND HIS WIFE, FROM THE FACE OF KYRIOS THE THEOS. IN THE MIDST OF THE TREE OF THE PARADISE. 9 AND KYRIOS THE THEOS CALLED ADAM AND SAID TO HIM: "ADAM, WHERE ARE YOU?" 10 AND HE SAID TO HIM: "I HEARD THE SOUND OF YOU WALKING AROUND IN THE PARADISE AND I BECAME AFRAID, BECAUSE I AM NAKED, AND I HID MYSELF." 11 AND HE SAID TO HIM: "WHO RELATED TO YOU THAT YOU ARE NAKED, IF YOU DID NOT EAT FROM THE TREE, OF WHICH I CHARGED YOU, 'OF THIS ALONE, NOT TO EAT FROM IT'?" 12 AND ADAM SAID: "THE WOMAN, WHOM YOU GAVE TO BE WITH ME, SHE GAVE ME FROM THE TREE, AND I ATE." 13 AND THEOS SAID TO THE WOMAN: "WHY DID YOU DO THIS?" AND THE WOMAN SAID: "THE SERPENT DECEIVED ME, AND I ATE."

14 AND KYRIOS THE THEOS SAID **TO THE SERPENT**: "BECAUSE YOU DID THIS, YOU ARE CURSED FROM ALL THE DOMESTIC ANIMALS, AND FROM ALL THE WILD BEASTS OF THE EARTH. UPON YOUR CHEST AND THE BELLY YOU WILL GO FORTH, AND YOU WILL EAT EARTH ALL THE DAYS OF YOUR LIFE. 15 AND I WILL PLACE ENMITY BETWEEN YOU AND BETWEEN THE WOMAN, AND BETWEEN YOUR OFFSPRING AND BETWEEN HER OFFSPRING. HE WILL KEEP WATCH OF YOUR HEAD, AND YOU WILL KEEP WATCH OF HIS HEEL."

16 AND **TO THE WOMAN** HE SAID: "I WILL GREATLY INCREASE YOUR PAINS AND YOUR MOANING - IN PAINS YOU WILL BRING FORTH CHILDREN. AND AGAINST YOUR HUSBAND WILL BE YOUR AVERSENESS, AND HE WILL MASTER YOU."

17 NOW HE SAID **TO ADAM**: "BECAUSE YOU LISTENED TO THE VOICE OF YOUR WIFE AND YOU ATE FROM THE TREE, OF WHICH I CHARGED YOU, 'OF THIS ALONE, NOT TO EAT FROM IT', CURSED WILL BE THE LAND FOR YOUR LABOURS. WITH PAINS YOU WILL EAT FROM IT ALL THE DAYS OF YOUR LIFE. 18 THORNS AND THISTLES WILL SPRING UP TO YOU, AND YOU WILL EAT THE PLANT OF THE FIELD. 19 BY THE SWEAT OF YOUR FACE WILL YOU EAT YOUR BREAD, UNTIL YOU RETURN TO THE EARTH, FROM WHICH YOU WERE TAKEN. FOR EARTH YOU ARE, AND TO EARTH YOU WILL DEPART.

20 THEN ADAM CALLED THE NAME OF THE WOMAN 'LIFE', BECAUSE SHE IS MOTHER OF ALL THE LIVING. 21 AND KYRIOS THE THEOS MADE TO ADAM AND TO HIS WIFE LEATHERN TUNICS, AND HE CLOTHED THEM.

22 AND THEOS SPOKE: "BEHOLD, ADAM HAS BECOME AS ONE OF US, ONE TO KNOW GOOD AND EVIL. AND NOW, LEST HE MAY STRETCH OUT THE HAND, AND MAY TAKE OF THE TREE OF LIFE AND MAY EAT, HE WILL EVEN LIVE UNTO THIS AGE." 23 AND KYRIOS THE THEOS SENT HIM AWAY FROM THE PARADISE OF THE DELIGHT, TO WORK THE EARTH, FROM WHICH HE WAS TAKEN. 24 AND HE CAST ADAM OUT AND SETTLED HIM DOWN ACROSS FROM THE PARADISE OF THE DELIGHT. AND HE ARRANGED THE CHERUBIM AND THE GLOWING LONGSWORD, THE ONE REVOLVING, TO KEEP THE WAY OF THE TREE OF LIFE.

1 NOW ADAM KNEW EVE, HIS WIFE. AND HAVING CONCEIVED, SHE BROUGHT FORTH CAIN, AND SHE SAID: "I ACQUIRED A MAN THROUGH THEOS." 2 THEN SHE PROCEEDED TO BRING FORTH HIS BROTHER ABEL.

AND ABEL BECAME A SHEPHERD OF SHEEP, BUT CAIN WAS WORKING THE EARTH. 3 AND IT FOLLOWED AFTER SOME DAYS - CAIN BROUGHT FROM THE FRUITS OF THE EARTH A SACRIFICE TO KYRIOS. 4 AND ABEL, HE ALSO BROUGHT FROM THE FIRSTBORN OF HIS SHEEP, AND FROM THEIR FAT PARTS. AND THEOS LOOKED UPON ABEL AND UPON HIS GIFTS, 5 BUT ON CAIN AND ON HIS SACRIFICES HE DID NOT HOLD ONTO. AND IT GRIEVED CAIN GREATLY, AND HE COLLAPSED ONTO THE FACE. 6 AND KYRIOS THE THEOS SAID TO CAIN: "WHY DID YOU BECOME GRIEVED ALL AROUND, AND WHY DID YOUR FACE COLLAPSE? 7 IF YOU SHOULD HAVE PRESENTED RIGHTLY, BUT MIGHT NOT HAVE DIVIDED RIGHTLY, DID YOU NOT SIN? BE QUIET! AGAINST YOU WILL BE HIS AVERSENESS, AND YOU WILL RULE HIM."

8 THEN CAIN SAID TO ABEL HIS BROTHER: "WE SHOULD GO OVER INTO THE FLAT LAND." AND IT HAPPENED, WHILE THEY WERE IN THE FLAT LAND, THEN CAIN ROSE AGAINST ABEL HIS BROTHER, AND HE KILLED HIM. 9 AND THEOS SPOKE TO CAIN: "WHERE IS ABEL, YOUR BROTHER?" BUT HE ANSWERED: "I DO NOT KNOW. AM I NOT A WATCHMAN OF MY BROTHER?" 10 AND THEOS SAID: "WHAT DID YOU DO? THE VOICE OF YOUR BROTHER'S BLOOD CRIES TO ME OUT OF THE EARTH. 11 AND NOW YOU ARE CURSED FROM THE EARTH, WHICH HAS OPENED WIDE ITS MOUTH, TO RECEIVE FROM YOUR HAND THE BLOOD OF YOUR BROTHER. 12 FOR YOU WILL WORK THE EARTH, AND IT WILL NOT CONTINUE TO GIVE ITS STRENGTH TO YOU. YOU WILL BE MOANING AND TREMBLING ON THE EARTH." 13 AND CAIN SAID TO KYRIOS: "MY FAULT IS TOO GREAT TO BE FORGIVEN TO ME. 14 IF YOU CAST ME OUT TODAY FROM THE FACE OF THE EARTH, AND I WILL BE HIDDEN FROM YOUR FACE, THEN I WILL BE MOANING AND TREMBLING ON THE EARTH, AND IT WILL BE THAT ANYONE FINDING ME, WILL KILL ME." 15 AND KYRIOS THE THEOS SPOKE TO HIM: "NOT SO. ANYONE KILLING CAIN, WILL RELEASE SEVEN RETRIBUTIONS." AND KYRIOS THE THEOS APPOINTED A MARK TO CAIN, TO NOT ANNIHILATE HIM ANYONE FINDING HIM." 16 NOW CAIN WENT OUT FROM THE PRESENCE OF THEOS, AND HE DWELT IN THE LAND OF NAID, IN FRONT OF EDEN.

17 AND KAIN KNEW HIS WIFE, AND HAVING CONCEIVED, SHE BROUGHT FORTH ENOCH. AND HE WAS BUILDING A CITY, AND HE SURNAMED THE CITY AFTER THE NAME OF HIS SON, OF ENOCH. 18 NOW TO ENOCH WAS BORN GAIDAD, AND GAIDAD BEGAT MEHUJAE, AND MEHUJAE BEGAT METHUSAE, AND METHUSAE BEGAT LAMECH.

19 AND LAMECH TOOK TO HIMSELF TWO WOMEN. THE NAME TO THE ONE WAS ADA, AND THE NAME TO THE SECOND SELLA. 20 AND ADA BROUGHT FORTH JOBEL. THIS WAS THE FATHER OF ANIMAL BREEDERS DWELLING IN TENTS. 21 AND THE NAME OF HIS BROTHER WAS JUBAL. THIS WAS THE ONE HAVING INTRODUCED PSALTERY AND HARP. 22 BUT SELLA, SHE ALSO BROUGHT FORTH THOBEL, AND HE WAS A HAMMERING SMITH OF COPPER AND IRON. AND THE SISTER OF THOBEL WAS NOEMA.

23NOW LAMECH SAID TO HIS OWN WIVES: "ADA AND SELLA, HEAR MY VOICE, O WIVES OF LAMECH! GIVE EAR TO MY WORDS! FOR I KILLED A MAN FOR A WOUND TO ME, AND A YOUNG MAN FOR A BRUISE TO ME. 24SINCE SEVEN TIMES HAVE BEEN RETRIBUTED OF CAIN, NOW SEVENTY TIMES SEVEN OF LAMECH."

25NOW ADAM KNEW EVE HIS WIFE. AND HAVING CONCEIVED, SHE BROUGHT FORTH A SON AND DESIGNATED HIS NAME SETH, SAYING: "FOR THEOS RAISED UP TO ME ANOTHER SEED INSTEAD OF ABEL, WHOM KAIN KILLED." 26AND TO SETH THERE WAS A SON, AND HE DESIGNATED HIS NAME ENOSH. THIS ONE TRUSTED TO CALL UPON THE NAME OF KYRIOS THE THEOS.

6NOW **SETH** LIVED TWO HUNDRED AND FIVE YEARS, AND HE BEGAT ENOSH. 7AND SETH LIVED AFTER HIS BEGETTING OF ENOSH SEVEN HUNDRED AND SEVEN YEARS, AND HE BEGAT SONS AND DAUGHTERS. 8THEN ALL THE DAYS OF SETH WERE NINE HUNDRED AND TWELVE YEARS, AND HE DIED.

9AND **ENOSH** LIVED ONE HUNDRED AND NINETY YEARS, AND HE BEGAT KAINAN. 10AND ENOSH LIVED AFTER HIS BEGETTING OF KAINAN SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN YEARS, AND HE BEGAT SONS AND DAUGHTERS. 11THEN ALL THE DAYS OF ENOSH WERE NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE YEARS, AND HE DIED.

12AND **KAINAN** LIVED ONE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY YEARS, AND HE BEGAT MAHALALEEL. 13AND KAINAN LIVED AFTER HIS BEGETTING OF MAHALALEEL SEVEN HUNDRED AND FORTY YEARS, AND HE BEGAT SONS AND DAUGHTERS. 14THEN ALL THE DAYS OF KAINAN WERE NINE HUNDRED AND TEN YEARS, AND HE DIED.

15AND **MAHALALEEL** LIVED ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE YEARS, AND HE BEGAT JARED. 16AND MAHALALEEL LIVED AFTER HIS BEGETTING OF JARED SEVEN HUNDRED AND THIRTY YEARS, AND HE BEGAT SONS AND DAUGHTERS. 17THEN ALL THE DAYS OF MAHALALEEL WERE EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE YEARS, AND HE DIED.

18AND **JARED** LIVED ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-TWO YEARS, AND HE BEGAT ENOCH. 19AND JARED LIVED AFTER HIS BEGETTING OF ENOCH EIGHT HUNDRED YEARS, AND HE BEGAT SONS AND DAUGHTERS. 20THEN ALL THE DAYS OF JARED WERE NINE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-TWO YEARS, AND HE DIED.

21AND **ENOCK** LIVED ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE YEARS, AND HE BEGAT METHUSALAH. 22NOW ENOCH WALKED WELL-PLEASINGLY TO THEOS AFTER HIS BEGETTING OF METHUSALAH FOR TWO HUNDRED YEARS, AND HE BEGAT SONS AND DAUGHTERS. 23THEN ALL THE DAYS OF ENOCH WERE THREE HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE YEARS. 24AND ENOCH WALKED WELL-PLEASINGLY TO THEOS AND WAS NOT FOUND, BECAUSE THEOS TRANSLATED HIM.

25AND **METHUSALAH** LIVED ONE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN YEARS, AND HE BEGAT LAMECH. 26AND METHUSALAH LIVED AFTER HIS BEGETTING OF LAMECH SEVEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO YEARS, AND HE BEGAT SONS AND DAUGHTERS. 27THEN ALL THE DAYS OF METHUSALAH, THAT HE LIVED, WERE NINE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE YEARS, AND HE DIED.

28AND **LAMECH** LIVED ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-EIGHT YEARS, AND HE BEGAT A SON. 29AND HE DESIGNATED HIS NAME NOAH, TELLING: "THIS ONE WILL MAKE US PAUSE FROM OUR WORKS, AND FROM THE PAINS OF OUR HANDS, AND FROM THE EARTH, WHICH KYRIOS THE THEOS CURSED." 30AND LAMECH LIVED AFTER HIS BEGETTING OF NOAH FIVE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE YEARS. AND HE BEGAT SONS AND DAUGHTERS. 31THEN ALL THE DAYS OF LAMECH WERE SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY-THREE YEARS, AND HE DIED.
